#### 1.0 Introduction

This statement is made by Mastermelt Ltd in accordance with section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015.

Modern slavery is a violation of basic human rights. It takes various forms, such as slavery, servitude, forced and compulsory labour and human trafficking, all of which have in common the deprivation of a person's liberty by another to exploit them for personal or commercial gain.

#### 2.0 About us

Mastermelt Ltd focuses on the recovery of precious metals from production scraps, waste streams and end of life products and components.

We promote an inclusive, safe and happy working atmosphere for all staff.

### 3.0 Scope

This statement applies to employees of all levels of Mastermelt Ltd as well as its contractors and outsourced workers.

## 4.0 Our Policy

We have a strict zero tolerance policy to any form of modern slavery or human trafficking. This includes any form of slavery, forced work, servitude or compulsory labour.

We are committed to ensuring zero modern slavery or human trafficking takes place anywhere within our supply chain, business ventures, dealings or business partners.

As stated in our Supply Chain Due Diligence Policy, we will neither tolerate nor profit from, contribute to, assist, or facilitate the commission of:

- Torture, cruel, inhuman, and degrading treatment;
- Forced or compulsory labour;
- Child labour;
- Human rights violations and abuses;
- War crimes, violations of international humanitarian law, crimes against humanity, or genocide.

All our Customers must sign to confirm their adherence to our Supply Chain Due Diligence Policy prior to us transacting with them.

We will not deal with and will immediately discontinue engagement with any Customer or Supplier where we identify a reasonable risk that they (or on any related entity) are breaching any terms of this Policy.

Any employee who breaches this policy will face disciplinary action, which could result in dismissal for misconduct or gross misconduct.
